WHEREAS, the "Owner" is the owner of the following Legal Land Descriptions:

WHEREAS The Owner desires the County to snowplow/grade his/her Agricultural locations when they become impassable or hazardous due to conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and the Owner for the consideration hereinafter named, agree as follows:

1. The County will determine whether the service can be provided without causing damage in terms of the width of the area or turning area.
2. The owner hereby agrees to prepay the hour (60 minutes) minimum set by the bylaw and the County will complete per policy.
3. The owner will advise the office when service is required.
4. Residents who request Agricultural Services may be subject to an additional roading fee.
5. The Owner hereby covenants and agrees that they will always indemnify and save harmless the County, their servants, agents, and employees from and against all loss, damage, or injury however caused, which may at any time during the continuance of this Agreement occur to any person or the property of any person including the Owner.
6. The Owner hereby covenants and agrees that any damage to the Owner's property resulting from snowplowing/grading operations shall be at the Owner's sole risk.
