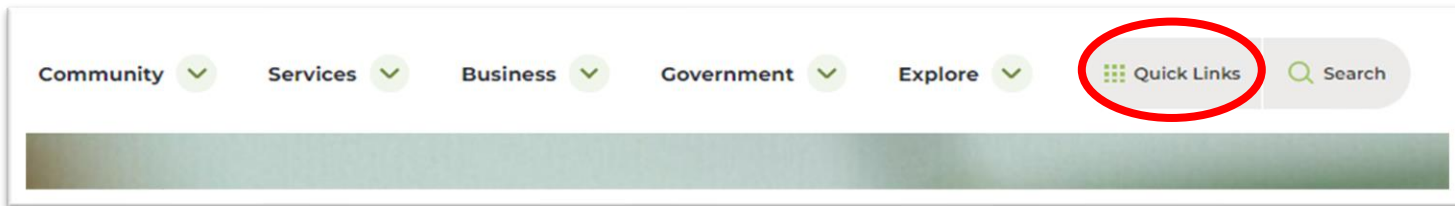


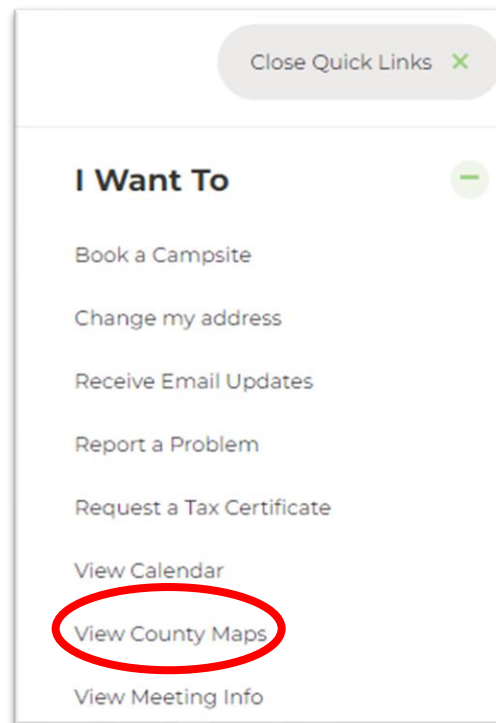
WEB MAPPING TUTORIAL



1. Go to our Beaver County website at: www.beaver.ab.ca.
2. On the upper right-hand side select **Quick Links**.




3. In the Quick Links drop-down menu select **View County Maps**.



- This will bring you to our [County Maps](#) page on our website. This includes all the maps from the Land Use Bylaw and Municipal Development Plan Bylaw. In addition, it provides you a PDF of the current land ownership map, and a link to the Beaver County Web Mapping Site.


Under the bolded headline “*Web Mapping Site*” select **GIS Mapping Site**.

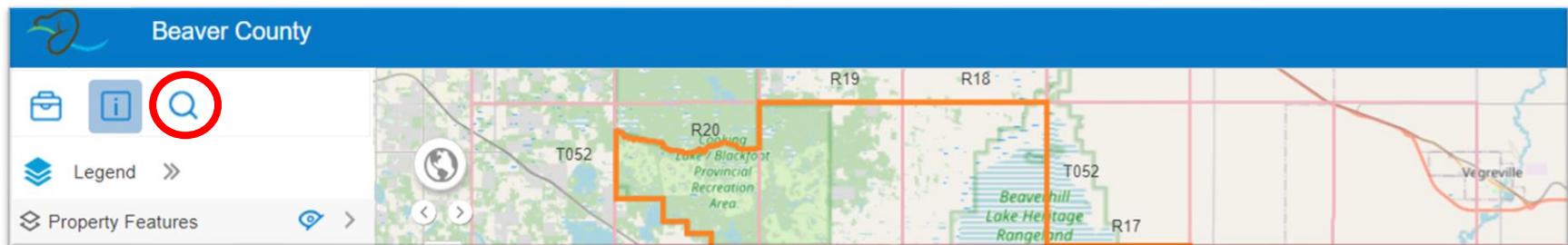

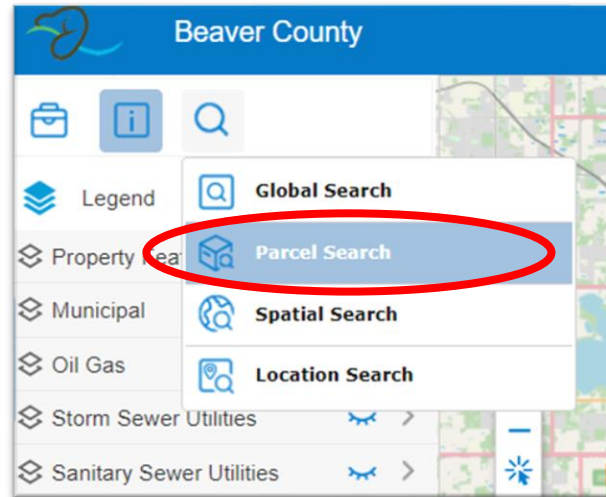

7. Once you have agreed to disclaimer you will be given access to the Web Mapping Site. On the left-hand side there is an array of options you can choose.

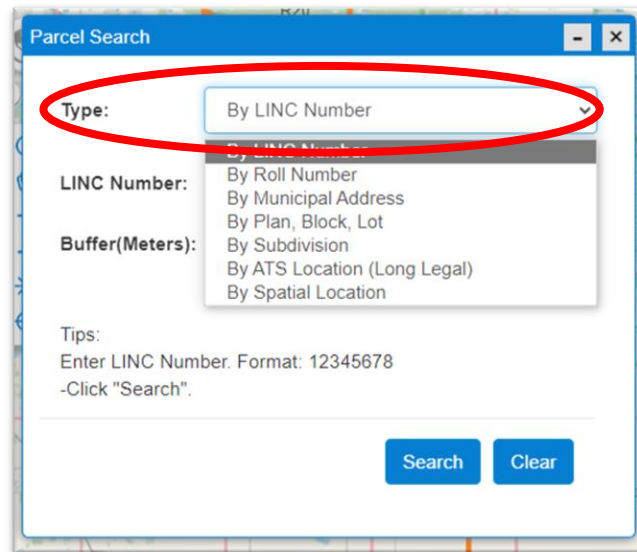
To search for a specific property, go to the top left-hand side of the page and select the button that looks like a **magnifying glass**.



8. In the drop-down menu select **Parcel Search**.




9. The "Parcel Search" box should be on your screen, and you can filter how you search by selecting the **Type** drop-down menu.




10. As an example, we will search a Beaver County owned parcel of land by the roll number (which can be found on your tax assessment notices mailed each year or by calling the Beaver County office at 780-663-3730).

In the **Type** drop-down, select **By Roll Number**.





11. Once selected, in the box labelled **Roll Number** type in the roll number for the parcel you wish to search (no spaces) and select **Search**.


12. After you click "Search" the **Search Results** box should be on your screen. You can view the property's details by selecting the **Detail Information** button.

13. Once selected, the "Detail Information" for the property selected should be on your screen. In addition to the property information, you can also view the assessment information by selecting **Assessment** on the top ribbon of the "Detail Information" screen. In addition, you can also choose to print each screen by selecting **Print**.



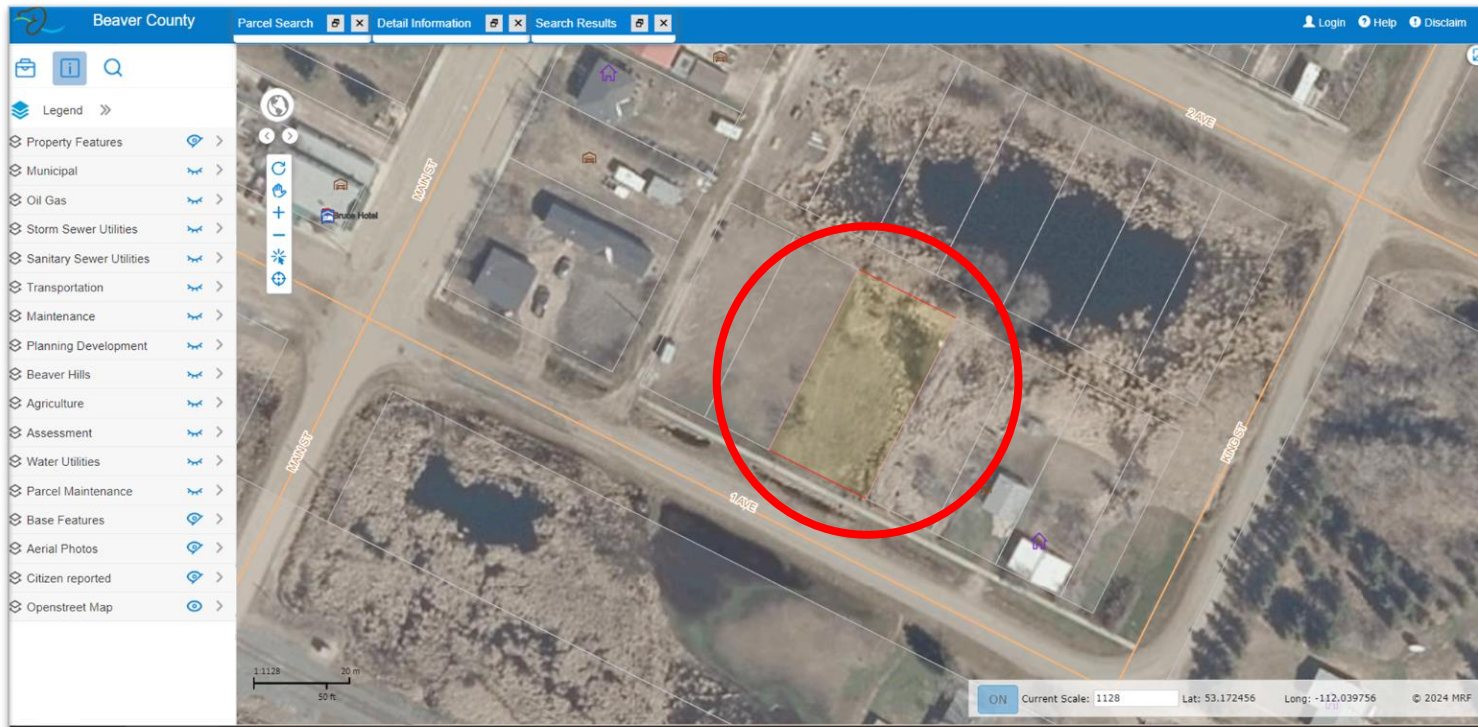
14. After you click "Search" the **Search Results** box should be on your screen. You can view the property on the map by clicking the **Zoom** button.

Once selected, the "zoom" button will bring you to a highlighted parcel of land on the interactive map.



15. At this point you can select from the drop-down menus on the left-hand side of the screen to change the views and see different features of the land. For example, if you want to view which electoral district you are in, under the **Municipal** drop-down menu, select **Electoral Districts**. Once you move your mouse back to the interactive map, the electoral district will appear.
