- Upon completion, the area backsloped is to be kept free of weeds, brush, rocks, and any other debris.
- The applicant shall submit a sketch of the area to be backsloped.

Please note the following County Responsibilities:

- The county will seed grass in the ditch following completion of the project if the location is not to be utilized for crop production.
- The County is responsible for the location of utilities (One Call) for work completed by the County.
- The County will not commence the work until the request is approved by County Council.
- The County will not commence any work until a written agreement is in place between the County and the Landowner.
- Council-approved backsloping projects will generally be completed after harvest and before freeze up.

Beaver County Council will limit the number of projects to a maximum of 3 (three) per year, and only 1 (one) 800 meter (maximum) project per Landowner per year. All applications are subject to inspection by County staff before and after the commencement of any work for conformance with the County Backsloping Policy INFR-002. If this backslope project is not approved in one calendar year, it will automatically be placed on the following year's project list for consideration by the Council.
