

SERVICEMAN/EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II

Employment Opportunity: Full-Time Seasonal - Temporary

Beaver County is seeking a dedicated Serviceman responsible for the daily and scheduled maintenance and service of a wide variety of mobile heavy equipment, automotive vehicles, small engines, agricultural equipment, highway trucks, and trailers. Based out of the Transportation shop, the Serviceman will support mechanics and the construction crew, ensuring optimal equipment operation and maintenance.

POSITION DETAILS:

- Hours of Work: Full time must be available to work non-regular hours if required, as per section six (6) "Hours of Work" of the Collective Agreement with I.U.O.E. local 955.
- Salary Range: \$28.08 - \$34.17 per hour.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform inspection, servicing, minor repairs, and maintenance of all county equipment, ensuring safe and efficient day-to-day operations.
- Document maintenance records and assist with inventory management.
- Support daily operations in the Transportation shop and in field operations.
- Proficiently operate overhead hoists, shop tools, and various pieces of mobile equipment such as loaders and graders.
- Assist the construction crew in operating equipment as needed.
- Carry out additional tasks as assigned by the supervisor.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma or equivalency preferred.
- Experience in related trades, operation, construction and maintenance is an asset.
- A valid Class 5 driver's license with an acceptable driving record is required; a Class 3 or Class 1 license with a Q endorsement is preferred.
- A driver's abstract will be required for successful applicants.

QUALIFICATIONS AND PREFERRED SKILLS:

- Ability to troubleshoot, repair, and maintain machinery or equipment.
- Must be able to work independently and in a team environment.
- Accountable for accuracy, efficiency and time management.
- Must be able to prioritize jobs and change priorities as conditions change.
- Familiarity with GPS and GIS technology is advantageous.

WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT:

- Heavy lifting (no greater than 50 lbs.) and periods of sitting, standing, kneeling, crouching.
- Ability to work both indoors and outdoors as required, while being willing to adapt to fluctuating climates and environmental conditions, including hot, cold, and wet weather.
