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#### Note:

- 1. Beaver County may construct one approach to each freehold quarter section from an existing developed road. One approach per fragmented parcel may also be permitted from an existing developed road.
- 2. Approval for widening of existing approaches or construction of additional approaches shall be as per the Road Approaches Policy PW-010.
- 3. Approaches shall be constructed to the County's Road Approach Standard.
- 4. Temporary approach removals shall be completed at the applicant's cost and the ditch restored to original or better condition by the removal date specified by the Special Provisions.
- 5. Applicant to notify Beaver County Public Works Department when approach is complete and ready for inspection.
- 6. Proposed new approach locations shall be inspected by Beaver County Infrastructure Department prior to approval.
- 7. Applicant shall clearly mark the proposed approach location by placing flagged stakes at both sides of the approach location.
- 8. Once the application is approved, if a culvert is required, the applicant must contact the administration office (780-663-3730) to schedule an appointment for pick-up of the recommended culvert size and coupler. The applicant should arrive in proper attire for loading and ensure that all Alberta Transportation specifications for transport are followed.
- 9. If the approach is not constructed by December 31 of the year the culvert was received, the culvert must either be returned, or the landowner will be responsible for reimbursing its cost.
- 10. Applicant to contact Alberta One Call and locate all buried utilities prior to construction.
- 11. Per the Fees, Rates, and Charges Bylaw, a pre and post construction inspection fee of \$125+GST is required prior to any new approaches being considered. Payment of the fee does not guarantee that the proposed approach will be approved and is not refundable if the application is denied.

- North arrow for orientation.
